
The Chateau of Ancy le Franc - Burgundy - France

The benefactor of Ancy le Franc, Antoine III of Clermont-Tallard, was the brother-in-law of the famous Diane de Potiers and a rich descendant of one of the oldest French noble families. The palace of Ancy le Franc and its original architecture was the model for the French architect Lescot when he reconstructed Louvre in 1546.

Late XVIIth century, the chateau was the property of the Ist Marquis of Louvois, famous war minister of Louis XIV, who conducted the project to turn Ancy le Franc into his private Versailles. The king's gardener Le Notre designed a vast French style garden in Ancy le Franc.

Did you know ?

Several kings of France were hosted in Ancy le Franc : Henry IV, Louis XIV, Louis XIII, ... The Marquise de Sévigné refers in her famous letters Ancy le Franc with its Italian style, as a French construction « in costume italiano ».

An amazing Renaissance Palace

On the banks of the Burgundy canal, not far from Chablis (between Auxerre and Dijon), Ancy le Franc, classified French historical monument, is an exceptional testimony of Renaissance architecture in France.

Masterpiece of the famous Italian architect of the king Francis I, Sebastiano Serlio, master of symmetry and balance, this palace is unique in France. Representative of the Renaissance 'art of living' and among the most beautiful constructions in France from the 16th century. This original quadrilateral holds one of the most important collections of Renaissance mural paintings in France.

Mural paintings attributed to artists from Burgundy, Flemish and great Italian masters of the School of Fontainebleau from the XVI^{th} et $XVII^{th}$ centuries.

The chateau is continuously being renovated since 1999. The treasures of Ancy le Franc are innumerable and the state and conservation of the site and estate are just exceptional. The lavishly decorated apartments, coffered ceilings, marble mosaic floors, sculpted wainscotings, the magnificent court yard, chapel, guards hall, long galleries, cabinets, royal apartment, private rooms, ... offer an unforgettable experience !
